As the end of February closes out CTE Month, we wanted to showcase some quick facts and figures regarding Career Technical Education.

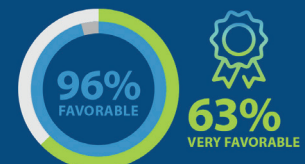
